

### Directions:

#### From Hartford (I-91 South)

Exit 17 (East Main Street). At the end of the exit, turn left onto East Main Street. At the fourth stop light, turn right onto Research Parkway. The Four Points by Sheraton will be 1/4 mile on the right.

#### From New Haven (I-91 North)

Exit 16. At the end of the exit, turn right onto East Main Street. At the fourth stop light, turn right onto Research Parkway. The Four Points by Sheraton will be 1/4 mile on the right.
