
From the South

PETER WRIGHT, ESQ. is an attorney who represents children with special educational needs. Pete struggled with learning disabilities, including dyslexia, dysgraphia and ADHD. His determination to help children grew out of his own educational experiences. In October 1993, Pete successfully represented Shannon Carter before the United States Supreme Court. The Supreme Court issued a unanimous decision on Shannon's behalf in Florence County v. Shannon Carter.

Since then, he and his wife have developed the "wrightslaw" special education law and advocacy website. It is the top ranked website in regard to special education advocacy for children with disabilities. He and his wife have also published the best selling special education law books entitled "Wrightslaw: Special Education Law" and "Wrightslaw: From Emotions to Advocacy." They have an online newsletter with over 35,000 subscribers. He is a member of Advisory Boards and Boards of Director for numerous disability related organizations.

PAMELA DARR WRIGHT is a psychotherapist who has worked with children and families since the 1970's. Her training and experience in clinical psychology and clinical social work give her a unique perspective on parent-child-school dynamics, problems, and solutions.

Pam has written extensively about raising, educating and advocating for children with disabilities and is the primary author of the Wright's two best selling special education law books, Wrightslaw: Special Education Law, and Wrightslaw: From Emotions to Advocacy. Pam publishes The Special Ed Advocate, a weekly electronic newsletter and manages several websites including, wrightslaw.com, fetaweb.com and yellowpagesforkids.com.
