PETER WRIGHT, ESQ. is an attorney who represents children with special education needs. Pete struggled with learning disabilities, including dyslexia, dysgraphia and ADHD. His determination to help children grew out of his own educational experiences. In October 1993, Pete successfully represented Shannon Carter before the United States Supreme Court. The Supreme Court issued a unanimous decision on Shannon's behalf in *Florence County v. Shannon Carter*.

Since then, he and his wife have developed the "wrightslaw" special education law and advocacy website. It is the top ranked website in regard to special education advocacy for children with disabilities. He and his wife have also published the best selling special education law books entitled "Wrightslaw: Special Education Law" and "Wrightslaw: From Emotions to Advocacy." They have an online newsletter with over 64,000 subscribers. He is a member of Advisory Boards for numerous disability related organizations.
